

High Quality, Christ-centered Education

Parkview Christian Academy's educational mission involves working with the home in the overall Christian education of students. In order for parents to maintain enrollment of their child/children or for families enrolling children, Parkview Christian Academy requires parents to affirmatively support and cooperate with the school.

As a parent:

- ✓ I agree to support the school and its Statement of Faith with my prayers and with a positive attitude. I also agree to support and adhere to all school policies. Complaints or negative comments will be shared only with the teacher, administrator, or person involved and not with my child or other people, following the Matthew 18 principle.
- ✓ I understand that Parkview Christian Academy stands firmly upon the historical truth claims and moral foundations of Christianity. This includes, but is not limited to, the biblical definition of marriage, the attendant boundaries of sexuality and moral conduct, and the clear biblical teaching that gender is both sacred and established by God's design. Parents, or the legal guardians, who choose to enroll their children at Parkview Christian Academy, are agreeing to support these and other basic biblical values derived from historical Christianity. I understand and agree that Parkview Christian Academy will teach these principles and biblical values.
- ✓ I understand that the School Board urges parents to recognize their scriptural responsibility (Deuteronomy 6:1-9, Psalm 78:5, 6, Proverbs 22:6) to provide their children with a Christian education and to understand that the primary responsibility for this task rests with the parents (Ephesians 6:4). Parkview Christian Academy was founded and continues to operate upon biblical values and the desire and commitment for Bible believing parents to enroll their children in an intentionally Christian environment. PCA will consider admission for students from any family who, despite their religious background or beliefs, are willing to support PCA's philosophy of Christian education, student conduct requirements, and the school's above stated positions and who are willing to allow their children to be educated and influenced in an intentionally Christian environment. Continued enrollment at PCA is contingent upon this same understanding and support.
- ✓ I understand that if at any time the school determines, in its sole discretion, that my actions do not support the ministry, or reflect a lack of cooperation and commitment to the home and school working together, the school has the right to request the withdrawal of my child(ren).
- ✓ I understand that all academic/behavioral records and information must be presented to the school before enrollment is finalized. If information that affects the classroom learning environment is withheld from the school, the school has the right to disensoll my child.
